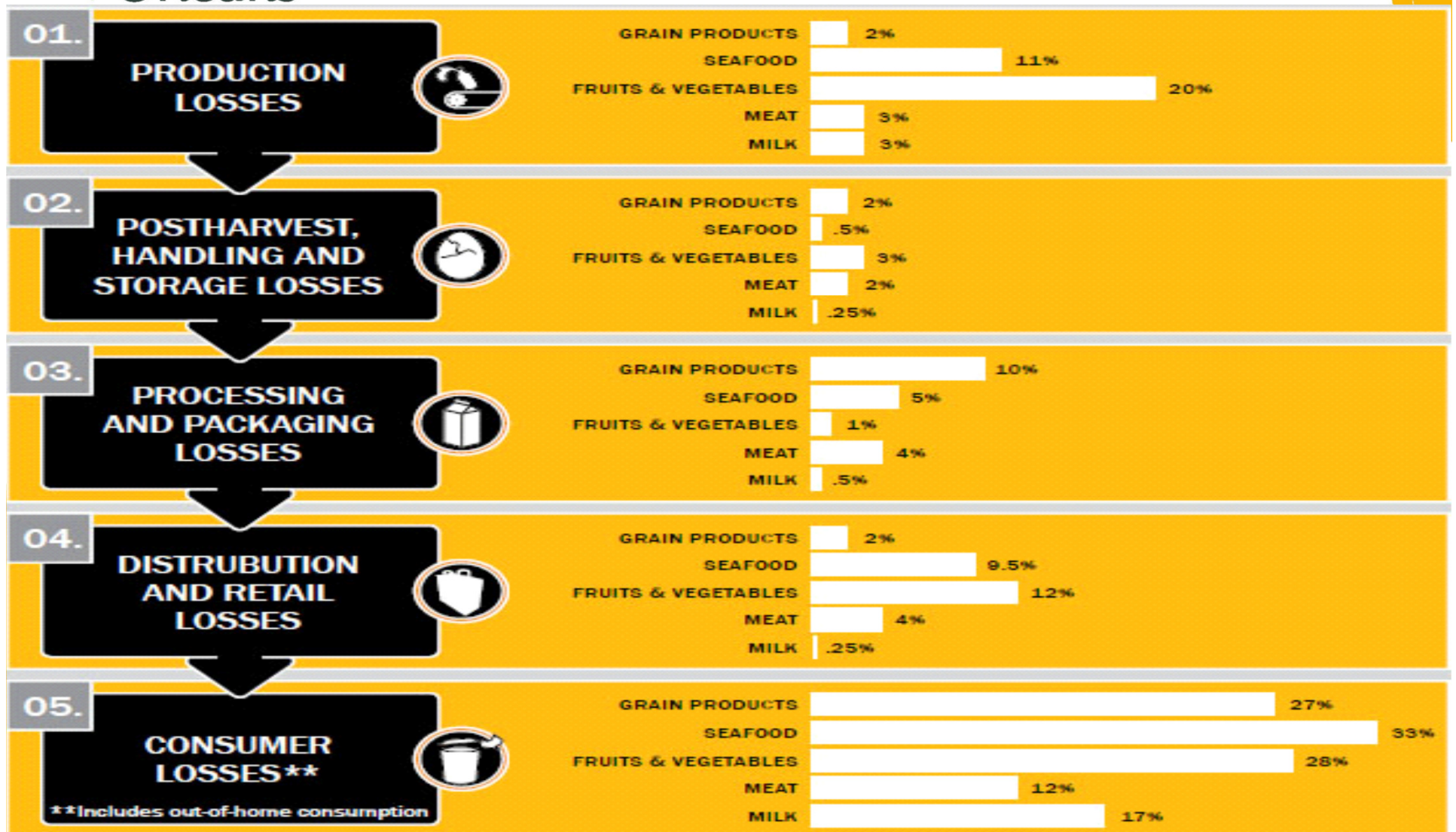

Food Safety Rules in Handling Cooked Foods

Following are instructions to set clear conditions for handling cooked foods and leftovers from parties and buffets throughout the different stages such as cooling down, storage, transport and reheating for consumption.

How does food become unsafe for consumption?

- Failing to cook food adequately to the right temperature
- Holding food at incorrect temperatures
- Using contaminated equipment
- Poor personal hygiene

➤ So keeping yourself and your work area clean at all times and holding and cooking foods at the correct temperature will go a long way towards preventing foodborne illness!

Cross-contamination: What is it, how does it happen and how to prevent it?

Cross-contamination occurs when microorganisms are transferred from one surface or food to another. A foodborne illness can result if cross-contamination occurs in any of these ways:

- Contaminated ingredients are added to food that receives no further cooking.
- Contaminated food touches or drips fluids onto ready-to-eat food.
- A food handler touches contaminated food and then touches ready-to-eat food.
- Ready-to-eat food touches contaminated surfaces.
- Contaminated cleaning towels touch food-contact surfaces.

➤ So keeping work surfaces and tools clean at all times, washing hands regularly and keeping raw foods away from cooked foods will go a long way towards preventing cross-contamination!
